On the occasion of Nagpanchami Organized National Tiger Day & know about Snakes Program ”

On the occasion of National Tiger Day the Department of Science organized Guest Lecture on “Know about Snakes ” on 29th July, 2025 at 10.00am. The main motive of this Lecture on focuses on conserving wild tigers and their habitats, with India hosting over 70% of the global population. Concurrently, world Snake Day promotes awareness of the 3,000 species, highlighting their role in ecosystem balance, controlling rodents & dispelling myths. Prathmesh Harne from B.Sc.-2 told information about the Snakes. Snakes are specialized limbless carnivorous reptiles found globally, except in Antarctica, Iceland, Ireland. Snakes consume rodents & insects, protecting crops & reducing the spread of diseases like Lyme disease. Educational helps distinguish between venomous & non venomous species, reducing panic & accidental bites. The program was organized under the guidance of Prin. Dr. Sambhaji Gavade. 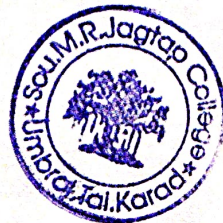
